## NORTH AMERICAN ANNUAL MEETING, ASSOCIATION FOR SYMBOLIC LOGIC March 20-23, 2009, University of Notre Dame, Indiana

**THE LOCATION.** Founded in 1842, the University of Notre Dame is an independent, national Catholic university located at Notre Dame, Indiana, adjacent to the city of South Bend, and approximately 90 miles southeast of Chicago. Whether you like the performing or visual arts, sports, music, or outdoor activities, South Bend has something for everyone. Located within driving distance from three major metropolitan areas—Chicago, Indianapolis, and Detroit—South Bend offers many of the same amenities of those larger cities.

Registration, book exhibits, refreshments and receptions will take place in McKenna Hall, Notre Dame's conference center. All conference sessions will be held in DeBartolo Hall, directly east of McKenna Hall. ARRIVAL BY AIR. South Bend is served by the following airports:

South Bend Regional Airport: The campus is a 10-minute taxi ride away. The fare cost is around \$15.00. Many car rental agencies are located in the airport if you are planning on renting a car.

**Chicago's O'Hare or Midway Airports**: Chicago, IL is 90 miles west of Notre Dame, IN. Most airlines have commuter plane services to the South Bend Regional Airport. There is bus transportation to campus from the Chicago airports by **CoachUSA**. If you choose to drive to South Bend from Chicago, follow the Indiana Toll Road (Interstate 80/90) instructions as stated below to campus. **ARRIVAL BY CAR**. The campus is located just south of the Indiana Toll Road (Interstate 80/90). From the Toll Road, use exit 77, which is the South Bend/Notre Dame-St. Mary's exit. Turn right (south) onto Indiana 933 (Michigan Street). Turn left (east) onto Angela Blvd. (the  $4^{th}$  light). Drive approx. 1 mile and turn left (north) at the first light, which is Notre Dame Avenue.
